

## Directions To The First United Methodist Church Jasper, Alabama



Our church is located at 1800 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, on the corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and 18<sup>th</sup> Street in downtown Jasper. We are across the street from the Walker County Courthouse Annex. On the next page we will give directions if you are coming from out of town.

**From Birmingham:** Coming in on U.S. 78 soon after you enter the city limits of Jasper you will soon come to Industrial Parkway where US 78 turns left to connect with Corridor X. **You will not turn here**, but continue on Highway 118 past Wal-Mart, past CVS and Walgreen's Pharmacies, Past Jasper Mall to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue where you will turn left between Hardees and the Chevron Station. Continue several blocks until the church comes into sight on the right.

**From Memphis or Carbon Hill:** Take the Highway 118 Exit to Jasper from Corridor X. As you come into the business district you will go under an overpass. Pass Captain Ds and go a couple of blocks and turn right between Hardees and the Chevron Station. Continue several blocks until the church comes into sight on the right.

**From Tuscaloosa:** As you come into town you will go under Corridor X. Continue until you intersect with Highway 269, **Do not turn left with Highway 69**, but go straight for several blocks, cross the railroad tracks and turn left at the second traffic light onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. One block and you will pass town square on the right. The church is one block on the left.

**From Parrish (Highway 269):** As you come into town you will turn right at the first traffic light. Go several blocks, cross the railroad tracks and turn left at the second traffic light onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. One block and you will pass town square on the right. The church is one block on the left.
